## Application Requirements

### **Bachelor's**

- ◆ Completion of a two-year interpreting degree (AA/AS/AAS)
- ◆ Cumulative **and** program GPA of 2.5 or higher
- ◆ Grade of "C" or better in all interpreting content courses

### **Master's**

- ◆ GPA 3.0 or GRE 1000
- ◆ Completion of BA/BS degree with minimum of an AA/AS degree in Interpreting **plus** state credential  
OR
- ◆ BA/BS degree in other field **plus** national certification
